



This is the Cookies Policy of Seaside Finolhu Maldives Pvt Ltd (“Seaside Finolhu”) which owns and operates the resort Finolhu Baa Atoll Maldives.

1. Definition of cookies and their function.

A cookie is a file that is downloaded to the user’s computer/Smartphone/Tablet (device) when accessing certain webpages, with the purpose of storing and recovering information about navigation or browsing habits associated with a particular device. 2. What kind of cookies does <https://www.finolhu.com/> use?

- **First-party cookies:** these are sent to the user’s terminal device from a device or domain managed by the editor, which provides the service requested by the user.
- **Third-party cookies:** these are sent to the user’s terminal device from a device or domain that is not managed by the editor but rather by another entity that processes the data obtained through the cookies.
- **Session cookies:** a type of cookie designed to collect and store data while the user accesses a webpage.
- **Persistent cookies:** in this type of cookie data continues to be stored in the user’s terminal and the data can be accessed and processed for a period of time set by the party responsible for the cookie, which may range from a few minutes to several years.
- **Analysis cookies:** whether processed by us or by third parties, these cookies allow us to quantify the number of users and, therefore, to statistically measure and analyse the use that users make of the service offered. This is done by analysing your browsing of our website to improve the range of products or services we offer.

2.1 Regarding the types of cookies, there are five big groups:

- **Analytical cookies:** they collect information about the use made of the website.
- **Social cookies:** these are required for external social networks.
- **Affiliate cookies:** they make it possible to keep track of visits referred from other websites, with which this website establishes an affiliation contract (affiliate companies).
- **Advertising and behavioural cookies:** these collect information about the user’s preferences and personal choices (retargeting).
- **Technical and functional cookies:** these cookies are strictly necessary for the use of this website and for the provision of the contracted service.



3. Disabling, revoking or deleting cookies

Users may, at any time, enable, block or delete the cookies installed on their device by selecting the appropriate settings on their browsers. If the installation of cookies is not allowed in their browser, it is possible that they may be unable to access certain sections of our website.
